- 2. Date of completion of application in the online portal for all Honours courses: **05.08.2022(Friday)**. **Note: A candidate can submit application in online portal for at most 4 honours subjects**.
- 3. Publication of Provisional Merit List for all Honours courses: 07.08.2022 (Sunday)(After 4 p.m.)
