Online Admission Schedule for 4 year (8 semester) Undergraduate Courses for the Session 2024-2025

Candidates will be admitted in 1st semester based on merit and according to the new and revised guidelines set by the University of Kalyani and Govt. of West Bengal (vide GO no. 554-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14 dated 21st August, 2024), for the few remaining seats, after completion of the first two phases of Central Counseling. The following norms and schedule are to be rigorously followed during the admission process.

- 1. Date of opening of the Online Portal for application for all UG Programmes: 12.09.2024 (Thursday).
- Note: In case, after submitting the form online, a candidate feels that the submitted form contains some error/s, he/she can rectify the same by using the "Form Correction Button" present in the menu, instead of filling a separate form again.
- Date of completion of application in the online portal for all UG Programmes: 13.09.2024(Friday).
 Note: A candidate can submit application in online portal for at most 4 Major subjects.
- Publication of Provisional Merit List for all UG Programmes: 14.09.2024 (Saturday) (After 1 p.m.)
 Note: For any error/ discrepancy in the Provisional Merit List, concerned candidate must inform the college in person or contact the Helpline Number as mentioned above.
- 4. Publication of Final Merit list for all UG Programmes: 15.09.2024 (Sunday) (After 10 a.m.)
- 5. Online admission for all UG Programmes will start from 15.09.2024(Sunday) [after 2.00 p.m.]. Note: Online admission for all the seats will commence simultaneously and will continue till either the seats are filled or the merit list is exhausted, whichever is earlier. Also note that the 1st round of counseling will last for TWO DAYS, subsequently it will be for ONE DAY or less depending on the situation.
- For admission criteria, candidates may visit the "Important Information" section in <u>kandirajcollegeonline.org</u>.
 Note: This is the guideline for admission of students in UG courses under University of Kalyani.
- Verification of testimonials of all admitted candidates will be done in class (once the session starts) as per the guidelines led down by the Govt. of West Bengal.
- For admission through Physically challenged quota, the candidate must have to possess certificate
 issued not below the rank of District level authority (District Hospital), without which his/her
 application for PWD quota will be rejected.

Note: Valid certificate (as per University guidelines) must be uploaded to the portal, without which the candidate will not receive the benefit of PWD quota.

 For admission through Economically Weaker Section (EWS) quota, the candidate must produce a valid EWS certificate issued by the competent authority, without which his/ her application will be rejected.

- 10. If at any stage it is found that the information given by the candidate is false, his/her admission will be liable to be rejected without any refund.
- 11. Candidates are hereby advised to follow the College website and/or notice board for any future notifications.
- 12. Documents to be uploaded at the time of online application:
- (a) Scanned copy of admit card of Madhyamik Pariksha or equivalent (File not exceeding 200KB).
- (b) Scanned copy of mark-sheet of Higher Secondary or equivalent. (File not exceeding 200KB)
- (c) Scanned copy of document for SC, ST, OBC(A/B), EWS, Physically challenged (If applicable) [Certificate from competent authority as mentioned above] (File not exceeding 200KB).
- (d) Scanned Photo (Passport size) and Signature of the candidate (Each file not exceeding 50KB).

 Note: Candidates are strongly advised to carefully scan and upload all proper documents in the
 - online portal, along with the online application. Failure to do so might lead to cancellation.
- 13. Documents to be produced at the time of verification
- (a) Receipt of payment for Admission/Counseling
- Downloaded copy of application form for Admission with pasted photo at the proper place duly signed by the Guardian and the applicant.
- (c) Proof of Date of Birth [e.g. admit card of M.P.] (Original and Photocopy)
- (d) H.S. Mark-sheet (Original and Photocopy) or, equivalent.
- (e) School Leaving Certificate (Original copy)
- (f) Caste/EWS/PH Certificate (as mentioned before) (Original and Photocopy)
